Honorable Members of the Parole Board,


One of the fundamental obligations of a Mayor is to protect the residents of their respective city. It has been brought to my attention of the possible parole of Mr. Charles Donald Corley, AIS 184756 in an upcoming hearing before you.

Since you are well aware of the case and circumstances, I will not fill this letter with statistics and redundant information regarding his case. In short, he is an ADMITTED child molester and the multiple offenses took place in the City of Homewood. We simply cannot take the risk of Mr. Corley being released back into this city. Back in 1995 the residents of Homewood took a visible stand against Mr. Corley and he was sentenced to 30 years in prison. We believe that 30 years means 30 years and he should not be released under any circumstances.

On behalf of the 25,000 residents of the City of Homewood and as Mayor, I respectfully request you DENY his parole thereby sending a message to all individuals that Homewood and the State of Alabama will not tolerate this kind of behavior toward our children.
